Top social work Program (U.S. News & World Report)

- ✓ Approximately 423 total MSW students and 50 PhD students
- ✓ Eight MSW concentration areas — American Indian and Alaska Native, Children, Youth and Families, Health, Individualized, Mental Health, Older Adults and Aging Societies, Violence and Injury Prevention, and Social and Economic Development
- ✓ Six MSW specializations — Management, Policy, Research, Sexual Health and Education; Social Entrepreneurship, and System Dynamics
- ✓ Seven joint degree programs, including a joint MSW/MPH degree

An innovative MPH program with approximately 155 students

- ✓ Four MPH specializations – Epidemiology/Biostatistics, Global Health, Health Policy Analysis and Urban Design
- ✓ Emphasis on interdisciplinary coursework
- ✓ Evidence-based practice integrated into coursework and field work

Introduction of MSP Dual Degree Program

华大-北大 社会政策双学位项目简介

The Washington University –Peking University dual Masters degree program aims to advance social welfare and the social work profession in China by training scholars and leaders who respond to global social policy challenges and promote just, equitable, and healthy societies around the world.

Students or alumni from the four masters-level programs offered by Peking University's Department of Sociology (Anthropology, Social Security, Social Work, and Sociology) are eligible to apply. Each student will receive a Master from Peking University as well as a Master of Social Policy from Washington University in St. Louis. For the Masters of Social Policy, students will study in-residence at the Brown School for 12 months.

MSP Curriculum 课程简介

Students are required to be in residence for one year at the Brown School to complete 5 required courses (15 credit hours), 3 elective courses (9 credit hours), and 1 internship (3 credit hours). Additionally, they are required to take 2 short courses (4 credit hours) that are offered by instructors from Brown School
